Don't Worry – Be Happy

Philippians 4:6 "Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God."

Romans 8:28 "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose."

In 1988, Bobby McFerrin's song, Don't Worry – Be Happy was all the rage on the radio. I remember singing along with this & thinking how nice to be so easy going. Offhand I don't remember what I was doing that year, probably finishing up college.

Now here we are in 2017 – 29 long years later and I am now approved for Ordination as a Teaching Elder by the Wabash Valley Presbytery. (Teaching Elder is the term used instead of Minister of Word & Sacrament) As a minister/ pastor it is my joy to lift up the worried and fearful with scriptures such as those above. Yet this past week, I have been anxious and worried about so much myself. Does this make me a hypocrite? Yes. Does this mean that I am human and weak just like everyone else? Yes. This does <u>not</u> mean that I believe the scriptures any less. I trust God completely -almost.

"In God we trust and everything else we check."--Air pilot's creed.

I heard these words many years ago and laughed. Yet how often do I apply this motto before the scriptures? I trust that I am not alone in this. It is in these times that I remember the father who had asked Jesus to heal his son. (Mark 9:23-25) Jesus hears the man when he declares his belief but pleads for help with his unbelief. Jesus hears *us* when we cry out in the same manner. "Jesus I trust you to care for my every need and to lead my life. Help me when I do not *feel* this belief strongly."


