The Best Prayers

²² We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. ²³ Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. ²⁴ For in this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what he already has? ²⁵ But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently. ²⁶ In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. ²⁷ And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will. Romans 8, NIV

Prayer is essential to our relationship with Jesus Christ. Prayer is essential to understanding who we are as the body of Jesus and the ministry we are called to be doing. Even with the knowledge that Jesus is an essential part of our prayers and the ministry to which we are called, we, too often, find ourselves molding "our" prayers and "our" ministry around ourselves and our needs.

I have often thought that my best prayers were a result of my weakness, when I did not know for what I should pray. As Paul shared in Romans 8:26, the Holy Spirit will intercede for us when we do not have words to express our need. These prayers are some of the few in which my concerns and needs do not take center stage. When I am weak, I actually find time in my weakness to just listen to what Jesus has to say. At these times I feel truly adopted and completely loved. Then I am renewed to step out anew in ministry in the vitality of my relationship with Jesus. My best prayers come from the Holy Spirit.

It is at these times that I experience the truth of Paul's words in Romans 8: "¹⁸ I consider that

our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us... ²⁸ And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. ²⁹ For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. ³⁰ And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified."

My prayer now is that in the coming months you, as the body of Christ, and I will remember that Jesus is doing a new work at Flora Presbyterian Church and in my life. The Word of God came to the people through Isaiah (43:19), "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?" We need to make sure we perceive the new that God is doing and not let our hurt or anxieties get in the way. We are assured that the new work of God will be for the good of all of us who love him. We were called to ministry together for the last 25 years, and now we are being called to separate ministries. The same faithfulness of God that has accompanied us for the last 25 years will lead and empower us in the future.


