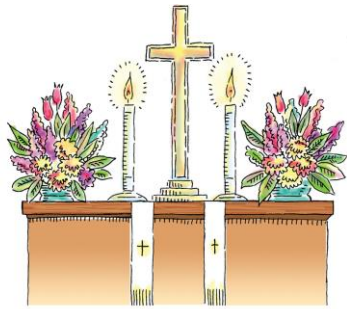

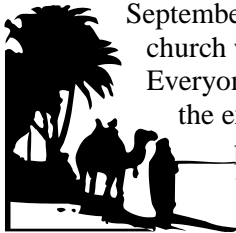

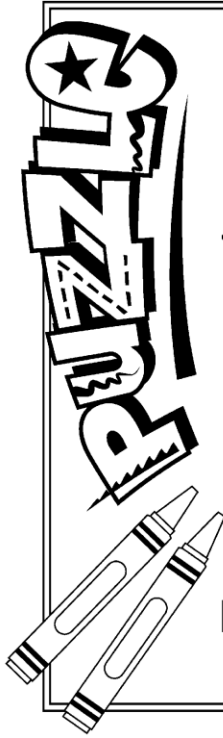


Junior Viney will be celebrating his birthday on September 12. It has been
