

"Beating the February Blues"



"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...
All things came into being with him...
What has come into being in him was life, and the life was the light of all peoples.
The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it."
John 1: 1-5

The month of February seems to be the darkest and coldest of all the winter months in central Indiana. The ground is frozen solid and that bitterly cold winter wind blows down from the Arctic. The nights are long and dark. Many of us find that our mood is more somber, and the light of the star that shone over the place where Jesus was born seems far in the past.

Yet even in the deepest darkness, the coldest night, we have the promise of heaven's light shining upon us from the resurrected Christ. Whenever we are depressed or discouraged, we can turn to Scripture to comfort and inspire us. The opening words of the gospel of John should be the theme song for the February blues. The light of Christ shines into even the darkest corners and illumines them with the clear light of love and grace. When the wind howls and the window glass rattles and freezes over, get out your Bible, brew a hot cup of tea and find comfort in the light that you will find there.

Just as the frigid weather of February softens into the spring rains of March, April, and May faith in the One whose light shines into our darkness and overcomes it is the promise of better spiritual weather to come. When we put our trust in the source of all peace and comfort we find a place of warmth, light, and joy within ourselves.

In Matthew 5: 14-16, we find these words that Jesus spoke to the crowds on the mountain: "You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven."

One of the deep spiritual truths of the gospels is that whenever you find the light of Christ through prayer and the reading of Scripture, that very light shines out from you into the darkness of the world. Christ is the light and we radiate that light into the lives of others who live around us. So, when the darkness gets you down, seek the light of Christ and brighten the darkness of your fellow travelers. That is how we overcome the February blues . . . through faith.

May the light of Christ illumine and warm all the dark places in your souls . . .


