

<u>WHAT IS</u> LOVE?

What is love? Everyone wants to talk about "God is love". Perfect love. The Apostle Paul tells the Corinthian church what love is and is not. His first letter to this church was in response to either questions from or reports that he had received about the church.

We need to remember that while love keeps no record of wrong that it also does not delight in evil. True parental love disciplines so that kids grow up knowing right from wrong and realizes that there are consequences to everything they do. Parental love also encourages the child to grow in wisdom, stature and in favor with God and people.

Pastoral love teaches the congregation that God forgives us when we sin but that we are to strive to respond to God's love with loving actions towards others.

Marital love stands with the spouse through sickness and in health, for better or for worse, in financial boom or bust.

In what ways do you share God's love with others? It's easy to do at church but what about at the Corner Café when others are choosing to use profane language that you know God does not like. Do you join in showing delight in evil? Or do you take mastery of your tongue and speak truth? I'm not saying that you should condemn a non-Christian for their speech, but to gently show by your own language a better way of expressing yourself.



When kids attend church- are you more concerned about their appearance or about welcoming them and encouraging their participation? What about the donations you make to the pantry? If Jesus was coming to dinner would you serve your offering to him? Take time this month to consider what true love really is from God's perspective. Take timeentionally show that kind of love to your family, your co-workers and your friends.


