
# If Only We Knew...

My sister would have been 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ , and I doubt she remembers it either. Somewhere in a photo album, there is another picture of that same rose bush several years later. It was much bigger and full of blooms. The post was no longer visible that once was so vital to give it its support. When the photo was taken, no one knew what would be happening in years to come, let alone what would be happening March of 2020, 54 years later.

We do not know what will have taken place by the time the COVID-19 has swiped through the entire world. 
